# Extreme Heavy-duty Tow and Recovery Vehicle

- 50 Ton Rotator or larger
- Traveling to and Returning from a Disablement scene
- Not for use when towing a disabled vehicle or doing crane work (i.e. lifting A/C units, stacking semi's for transport, etc..)
- Must obtain a truck specific approved routing map every 2 weeks

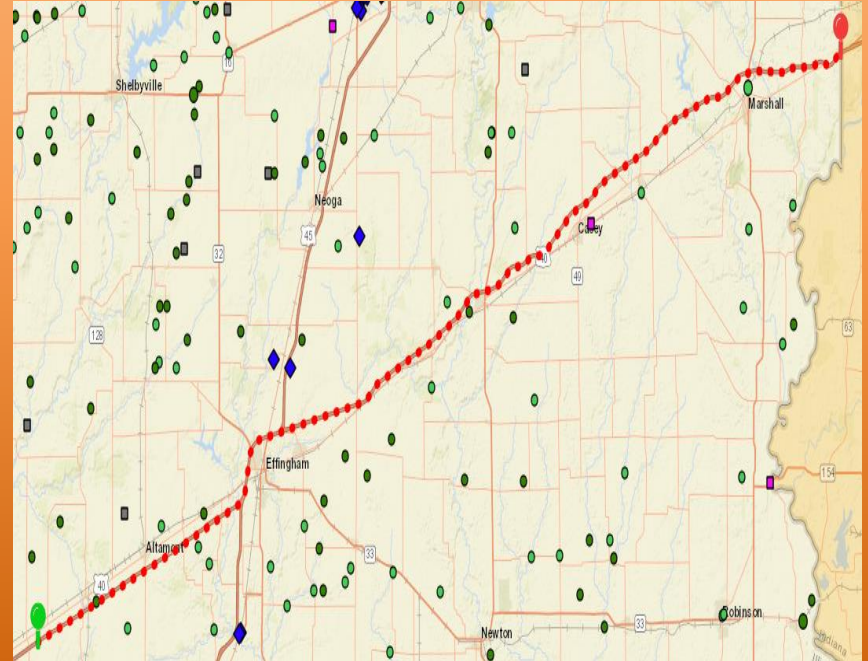
